Encompassing six city blocks adjacent to the University of Pennsylvania, University Square makes crucial connections and linkages between the campus and the surrounding West Philadelphia neighborhood. At the heart of University Square is The Inn at Penn, a 259-room full-service hotel, including banquet and meeting rooms, a restaurant and bar, and the relocated University Faculty Club. Hotel conference facilities include a 20-person trustee boardroom, a mix of meeting spaces, and a 500-person ballroom. The six-story hotel, which features views to Locust Walk on campus and to downtown Philadelphia, sits above street-level retail shops. The shops line the street edges and create active, pedestrian-friendly streets.

Elkus Manfredi Architects provided the master plan for University Square and complete architectural design services for the Inn at Penn and the retail components, collaborating with landscape architects, Andropogen Inc., and hotel interior designers, Brennan Beer Gorman Monk.
