Elkus Manfredi has designed one of Boston's hottest new restaurants, Via Matta, a 7,000-square-foot Italian trattoria in The Heritage on the Garden. The space is divided into three distinct areas. The main dining room is simple and classic in design with off-white walls and dark wood flooring with found objects, contemporary paintings, and trapeze lighting. French doors framed with velvet drapery in the front of the dining room open out onto sidewalk café dining.

A smaller interior café is dark and sultry with cork-finished walls, a mosaic tiled bar, and warmly glowing antique Italian light fixtures. Between the two dining areas is a full-service bar area with an old-world feel of antique mirrors and dark wood millwork contrasted with modern Italian glass art objects.
